

3D Vignette Pet House

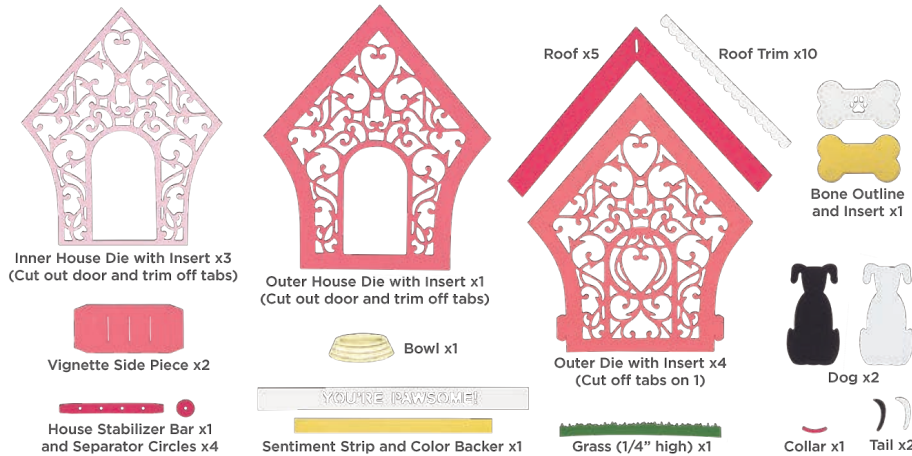
Supplies:

- Platinum™ or Platinum 6™ Machine
- Cardstock in various shades of Pink, White, Black, Green, Mirror Gold
- Bearly Art Glue PCG02E
- Basic Crafting Tools

Approximate Finished Size:
1.50 x 4.75 x 5.05 in | 3.8 x 12.1 x 12.9 cm

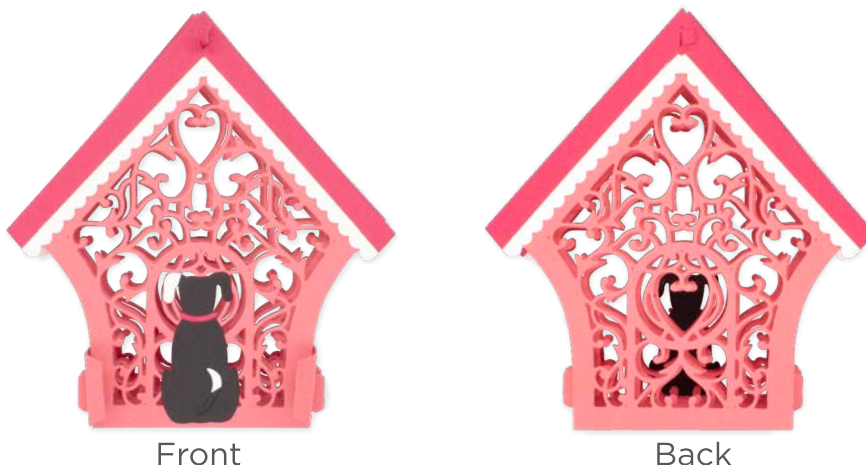

Cut pieces as shown.
Note that there is a circle die included that can be used to create a birdhouse!

Add trim to roof and adhere roof to top of each layer of the house. Make sure that the slots on the top of the roof layers are evenly glued to the house layers so that the stabilizer bar will be able to easily thread through the slots.
Bend tabs on 3D Vignette Side Pieces. Insert 3 house layers with tabs into one side piece, then the other.
Attach die cut pet and add to the “door” on the second layer of the Pet House (first layer will be added later).
Adhere back layer (facing out) to the tabs on the back of the Vignette side pieces, making sure it sits evenly with the center layers.

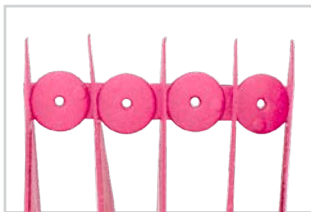

For the front of the house, adhere the light pink layer onto the house with the roof. Add grass to bottom as shown. Add bone, sentiment and water bowl with foam adhesive to add depth.

Glue to the tabs on the front of the Vignette side pieces, making sure it sits evenly with the other layers.

Stabilizer Bar
with Separator Circles



For the top of the house, run stabilizer bar through slit at the top of the layers. Glue bent tab of stabilizer to one end, then the other.

Turn piece to the side and line up separator circles to the holes on the stabilizer bar, gluing in place (tweezers work best for this). This will help stabilize the top and still be able to fold flat for mailing (padded envelope recommended).
